Paul Peddie & the Mt Disappointment Rotunda

I'm sure most of you know Paul, he's the little guy that is always smiling and offering assistance to anybody that needs it in the club, what most of you aren't aware of his undying passion for horse riding in the Mt Disappointment area, Paul has been instrumental in getting horse yards erected at the No1 horse camp and is constantly working with the DEPI to improve the area for all recreational horse riders, he recently led the "Travellin' Ten" club on their annual 10 day ride, this year it was in and around the Mt Disappointment & Flowerdale areas, the ride was organised by fellow member Allan Schulz and Paul was the ride leader, for those that aren't aware, this club runs a 10 day ride every year in a different location and donates the proceeds to worthy charity's, in 2014 they decided to donate \$2500-00 to Paul to assist with his ongoing efforts to convince the DEPI that a rotunda was desperately needed at the No1 horse camp, he asked several clubs that he leads rides for throughout the year (RCTHRC, MTHRC, GDTR & Travellin' Ten) to assist with letters from the clubs endorsing his request for the rotunda, he also approached the ATHRA board for assistance and that was also granted, he was able to convince the DEPI that as the camp was being used by many recreational trail riders a rotunda was needed year round for riders to gather at and shelter from the weather when they were at the camp.

He is also working with ATHRA to have the tracks marked with special ATHRA Trail Marker signs. So next time you are at the camp (RCTHRC ride in November 16th) and sitting under the rotunda enjoying a cool drink think of Paul and all his efforts to make your ride that little bit more enjoyable.


