**These conditions are part of our Ride Risk Assessment Plan**

<b>Ride Register:</b>	All participants <b>must</b> sign the ride register upon arrival at the ride base. A parent or guardian <b>must</b> sign the register for junior riders (under 18)A
<b>Helmets:</b>	<b>All junior riders (under 18) MUST wear AS/NZ 3838 or ASTM F 1163 helmets that are no more than five years old.</b>
<b>Code of Conduct</b>	Participants will be required to adhere to the ATHRA Code of Conduct which can be found at <a href="http://www.athra.com.au">http://www.athra.com.au</a> .

## Ride Information

<b>Start Time:</b>	9:30 AM for 10:00 AM start. PLEASE BE ON TIME.
<b>Directions:</b>	The ride will start from the turnaround at end of cul-de-sac Bingley Way in Wamboin, where there is room for parking floats on road verge <b>UNLESS</b> you hear otherwise.
<b>Ride Description:</b>	This is a 3 hour ride ( approx 14 kms) through the Kowen Pine Forest, along shady forest tracks, stopping for a relaxing BBC lunch at the Kowen picnic area.
<b>Ride Difficulty:</b>	Easy walking pace. Some of the tracks are rocky and there are a couple of medium hills.
<b>Ride Warnings/Alerts:</b>	Forest is used by cyclists, walkers.
<b>Grid/Map/GPS reference:</b>	
<b>Estimated Duration:</b>	3hours riding time (14 kms)
<b>First Aid:</b>	A basic first aid kit will be carried on the ride.

<b>Emergency Contact:</b>	<b>Mobile phone coverage is intermittent. Hand-held radios and PLB will be carried.</b>
<b>Horse Fitness:</b>	<b>Suitable for moderately fit horses.</b>
<b>Catering:</b>	<b>To be confirmed. Bring water. Plan is to carry lunch in a pack-saddle to picnic area for a sausage sizzle lunch.</b>
<b>Equipment:</b>	<b>Bring headstall and lead rope for tying or leading your horse.</b>
<b>Horse feed:</b>	<b>Please bring your own.</b>
<b>Water Availability:</b>	<b>Dams at morning tea stop and picnic area for horses.</b>
<b>Horse Shoes:</b>	<b>Some tracks are very rocky so, if your horse is unshod we recommend that you carry hoof-boots.</b>
