The Trail Boss Accreditation Course will be held on Saturday 13 & Sunday 14 March 2021. Course trainers will be Pam Lamshed and Jenny Henderson.

The Trail Boss course will be held at the Gooloogong Recreational Grounds, Racecourse Course Road, Gooloogong NSW 2805 which is about 4 hours west of Sydney.

If you haven't registered by 1 February 2021, you may have missed out. Please email gooloogong.trailclub@gmailcom to clarify the numbers and bookings if your are interested. This course is available to all ATHRA members and Clubs so please book in early so that you are not disappointed.

The cost is \$50.00 per participant. Please pay this directly into the Gooloogong Trail Club Account BSB 062 529 A/c 10013362 reference being your name, ie lynne livingstone, at the time of submitting your registration form.

There is a Chinese restaurant at the Country Club. The grounds are within walking distance of where the Course will be held. Gooloogong also has a free caravan park in the township with showers and toilets. There are also rooms at the local Hotel.

Leading Horses on our Club Rides

It was unanimously carried at our Committee meeting that 'any rider on our Club sanctioned ATHRA trail rides will not be permitted to lead another horse. There are to be no led horses on any of our Club sanctioned rides'. Other ATHRA Clubs don't allow it. ATHRA states in the code of Conduct 3.17 that the pre-ride check is to ensure that each rider is carrying a halter and lead rope with them on every ride.

Smoking On Our Club Rides

- No smoking whilst mounted
- No smoking during our morning tea or lunch break unless you are well away from the others. Please be considerate.

Pre-Paid Rides

You can now prepay for your ride by depositing into our bank account but of course cash can still be paid on the day. It's your choice.

<u>Please note:</u> All potential new members must have a pre-ride at Scheyville (or some other location) with an existing member to make sure that they and their horse are suitable to join our Club.

- New members joining now will be valid until 31 December 2021

Trail Tips

For your safety and the safety of others:

- Always ride between the trail boss and the tailer
- DON'T STRAY AWAY FROM THE GROUP
- Always carry a halter and lead rope
- Always carry water and a snack
- If the terrain is rocky and rough, please remember the hooves beneath you and have your horse shod or wearing suitable non-rubbing boots
- Mobile coverage is not always possible
- Be aware of carrying 'hard' items in a back pack. If you come off you could get badly injured. Also riding under low branches with a back pack is not a good idea
