RIDE REPORTS

Trail Ride from Irwin's Road February 11th 2021

This trail ride was a 9.00 am start but for February it was not hot. There were four riders Keith, Margaret, Carol and Clemmy. We set off along the fence line across the road to get onto Irwin's Trail and turned right to go up to Metz Road. We then went along Northern Fire Road to Bulmer's Road and down a trail to Widges Trail and onto Gilfillans's Road. The causeway was flowing due to the recent rains. From there we went to Ramseys Road along Forest Oak Road and picked up a trail that brought us back to Ramseys Road. This trail was good for the horses as there was around 20 trees down across it that the horses had to pick their way over which they all did well. From there we made our way back via Metz Road and Irwin's Road. The ride was around 3 hours and approximately 15kms and a lovely ride with clear weather.

Trail Ride in Yarratt Forest March 13th 2021

Five members attended this trail ride Keith, Margaret, Carol, Lyn and Clemmy. It was a clear day after the recent rain. We set off at 10.00 am down Main Road and then turned left onto Graded Ridge Road following this to the end and turned right onto Eastern Boundary Road. The trails were quite slippery for the horses as they went down grades and there was water across the lowest points on the trails. From there we rode to Tidsdel's Trail and cut across to Musgrove Trail and then took the four wheel drive track up to Main Road. This is about the halfway point and I know Digger then put a little more pep in his walk knowing we had started our return trip. From there we just picked up Musgrove across to Tidsdells picking up the car trail to Eastern Boundary Road and doubling back to the floats.

Keith brought his new stock horse gelding Tazzer. Keith has been riding him since he bought him around 9 weeks ago. Tazzer is a fine looking 15.3 chestnut gelding who Keith intends to use on endurance, you could see he has muscled up since Keith bought him.

The trail ride was 12kms and we took around 2 ½ hours at the walk. Of course there was a lot of talking catching up on news, we even came across a wild dog on Tidsdel's Trail. Everyone enjoyed their ride.

Shod or NOT? Several members have enquired as to whether they should have their horses shod. Many of our trails are stony so the club **recommends that horses are shod**.

RIDE DEPARTURE TIMES Riders – remember that the advertised times are the departure times – so please be courteous to your ride co-coordinator and other riders and get to the ride base early enough to prepare your horse and be ready to **ride out** at the scheduled time.
