<u>RIDE REPORTS</u>

Trail Ride in Yarratt Forest 25th November 202While this ride was originally going to be run from Coopernook NSW Headquarters due to the amount of rain that had fallen in the previous days it was diverted to the corner of Main and Old Landsdowne Road in Yarratt Forest Taree. On arrival the sky was overcast and looked like rain but we decided to give it a go. Margaret and I were the only riders on this trail ride so as I had brought Shannarra we rode some of the old new tracks that we have found between Lyn and myself using old forestry maps and



Apps for riding on our phones. We went down Old Landsdowne Road from where we parked and not long before that horrid creek crossing there is an old 4WD track that brings you out on the other fork of Old Landsdowne Road and then followed that to Eastern Boundary Road. We then turned right and followed this until the 4WD track I call the Car track which brings us onto Tidsdel's Trail, we turned right again and crossed over Main Road and followed the track that heads towards Western Boundary Road. We then took a left onto another 4WD track that picks up Western Boundary Road, we weren't on that for long and then found another old 4WD track that brings you back onto Main Road. We turned right onto Main Road and stayed on it to return to our floats. There was plenty of water about but we could skim around the perimeter of it. Shanarra will do that without asking in preference of getting her hooves wet. I am sure when the water is muddy she thinks there could be crocodiles lurking in there. Clemmy
